## Publicly-disclosed survivors

---

Individuals who have shared their lived experience of childhood sexual violence and have consciously decided to recognize themselves publicly as survivors

## Non-disclosed survivors

Individuals who have the lived experience of childhood sexual violence but have not chosen to recognize themselves publicly as survivors. They may have disclosed within their community, small group of colleagues/friends, or advocacy networks but chosen not to share more broadly

## Allies

Individuals without the specific lived experience of being the target of childhood sexual violence. They may have someone close to them who experienced sexual violence and have a personal connection to the issue
